PAINTING

- A2 approx size acrylic pad or mixed media pad
- Starter acrylic set (offers a basic range of colours which can be supplemented over time, suggest 60-75ml sized tubes) liquitex, systems 3, Daley Rowney are reasonably priced and of reasonable quality
- Water pot
- Rag
- Brushes - acrylic starter set of mixed sized brushes. Include 1 big brush like a 1.5 inch household brush (pick up one from Asda or B&Q etc)
